MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING DEVELOPED FOR TEENS BY TEENS



Researchers at the University of lowa are recruiting students in grades 6th through 12th to participate in a 4-module, mental health training.

WHAT TO EXPECT

1. Parent or guardian completes an online survey to grant permission, if ages 13-17.

OR

If you are 18 or 19, you complete an online survey consenting to participate in the project.

- 6-12th grade student completes online survey collecting prelminary information and you are contacted for scheduing.
- Student participates in an in-person, CRATERS training at UI College of Public Health (dates November 1 or 15, 2025: 8a-4p)
- 4. Student completes 2 follow-up surveys, immediately after workshop and 30 days later.



REQUIREMENTS

- > Enrolled in grades 6th through 12th in Iowa City or surrounding areas
- > Consent from Parental or legal guardian
- > Student assent (willingness)
- > Transportation to and from site

- > Online surveys: 15-20 minutes each.
- CRATERS training: 1, 8-hour day
